



We, the Bath Fest Committee, on behalf of the Town of Bath, would like to welcome you to participate in Bath Fest.

Our event will be held at Bonner's Point on Saturday, May 10, 2025.

FESTIVAL SPECIFICS FOR VENDORS

Each application must be accompanied by a \$30.00 check payable to **Bath Fest, P.O. Box 291, Bath, NC 27808** before May 2, 2025. Late entries will be permitted only if special arrangements have been made in advance. Failure to attend will result in forfeiture of entry fee.

Entries for Artists will be divided into two categories – Crafts and Fine Arts. All artwork must be an original creation by the artist. No commercial items will be allowed for sale. If a representative of the Bath Fest Committee decides that items are not the Vendor's original work, the Vendor will be asked to remove the items from their display. Vendors must exhibit a minimum of 20 pieces. You must be present to display and you must stay for the duration of the event.

No electricity is provided or allowed, you are responsible for your belongings, including any loss or damage, you are responsible for your own taxes.

There is no charge for Civic Groups operating concession stands but an application and waiver must be completed and received. There is no charge for non-profit groups.

Displays must be set up between 8:00-9:30 am with break down between 3:00-4:00 pm. Please respect this time period and have displays remain intact until after the event closes. In case of an emergency, or if someone in your party needs to arrive or leave early, please notify a Bath Fest Committee member and special arrangements will be made. We are a rain-or-shine event.

No automobiles will be allowed to park or traverse the event area between 9:30am and 3:00pm. Please refer to map on website regarding event area entrances and exits. Traffic for setting up and breaking down moves one-way from the event entrance at S. Main and Craven Streets. To keep road blockages to a minimum, please unload and remove your vehicle from the event area before setting up.

Traffic control measures will be in place to ensure vendors park in the designated parking area after setting up. The grassy area to the left off of Front St. beyond the Bonner House will be used by multiple entertainment groups and 4-H during Bath Fest 2025 and is not a designated parking area. This area is also reserved for handicapped parking.
